NOTES:

To Clean:

- PANTRY & CABINETS: TOSS EXPIRED FOOD & ORGANIZE WHAT'S LEFT
- DISINFECT ALL THE TOYS WITH A MIX OF VINEGAR & WATER
- CLEAN WINDOWS INSIDE & OUT
- WIPE OFF BASEBOARDS
- WASH THE COUCH CUSHIONS COVERS & VACUUM UNDERNEATH
- GIVE THE BATHROOM A GOOD SCRUB...YES, ALL OF IT
- FLIP & ROTATE YOUR MATTRESS (WASH THE SHEETS WHILE YOU'RE AT IT)
- HAVE THE KIDDOS CLEAN UNDER THEIR BED
- VACUUM OUT YOUR CAR, ESPECIALLY UNDER THE CARSEATS
- CLEAN THE VENTS (OR CONTACT A PRO TO REALLY GET IN THAT HVAC)

To Organize:

- ORGANIZE YOUR NIGHTSTAND

- ORGANIZE THE LINEN CLOSET: SHEETS & TOWELS PAST THEIR PRIME NEED TO GO
- PUT AWAY THE EXTRA SHOES PILING UP IN THE MUDROOM

To Donate, Recycle, or Toss:

- IF YOU HAVE CLOTHES IN YOUR CLOSET THAT YOU HAVEN'T WORN IN A YEAR, LET THEM GO
- CLEAR & DISPOSE OF ANY EXPIRED MEDS IN THE MEDICINE CABINET
- CHECK YOUR SOCKS & UNDERWEAR DRAWER, IF WORN OUT = PITCH IT
- ROTATE, SELL, OR DONATE TOYS THAT HAVEN'T BEEN PLAYED WITH IN A WHILE
- SORT OUT KID'S CLOTHES THAT DON'T FIT & DONATE OR SELL THEM
